## **NEW LNG IUS: GOOD FOR 5 YEARS**



Kyleena™ (levonorgestrel-releasing intrauterine system; IUS) 19.5 mg, from Bayer, is a new hormonal contraceptive device used to prevent pregnancy for up to 5 years. The

small, flexible plastic, T-shaped long-acting reversible contraceptive can be distinguished from other IUSs by the combination of the visibility of the silver ring on ultrasound and the blue color of the removal threads, says **Bayer. To use LapCap<sub>2</sub>, says Life Care, center it over the umbilicus, attach a hose to the suction port, and apply negative pressure. The abdomen immediately rises for Veress needle insertion. Inert gas is then delivered to replace the negative pressure, and the procedure can continue.
