Teflaro

Allergan announces US Food and Drug Administration approval of a supplemental new drug application for Teflaro (ceftaroline fosamil) to expand the label to include the treatment of children aged 2 months to less than 18 years with acute bacterial skin and skin structure infections (ABSSSI) including infections caused by methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* and community-acquired bacterial pneumonia (CABP) caused by *Staphylococcus pneumoniae* and other designated susceptible bacteria. Teflaro is a bactericidal cephalosporin with activity against both gram-positive and gram-negative pathogens. Teflaro is already approved for ABSSSI and CABP in adult patients.
