

Drug-eluting stents

In the review article entitled “Understanding and minimizing late thrombosis in drug-eluting stents” published in the February 2007 issue of the *Cleveland Clinic Journal of Medicine* (2007; 74:129–136), a callout in the margin of page 132 was incorrectly included during copy editing, implying worse

clinical outcomes with stent thrombosis after drug-eluting stenting compared with bare metal stenting. Although, as described, formation of collateral blood vessels may be inhibited, there is no clinical evidence to date documenting any excess risk in this regard.
