
Rates of gestational diabetes in the United States, 2020

The 2020 incidence of gestational diabetes (GDM) in the United States was 7.8 per 100 births, an increase of 30% from 2016. Rates of GDM increased with increasing maternal age, prepregnancy body mass index, and plurality. Alaska had the highest rate of GDM, at 12.6%, and Mississippi had the lowest, at 4.7%.
