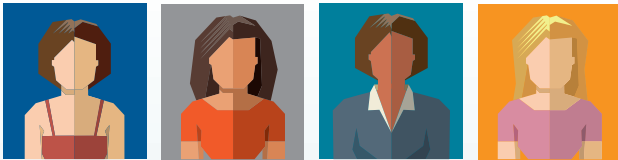


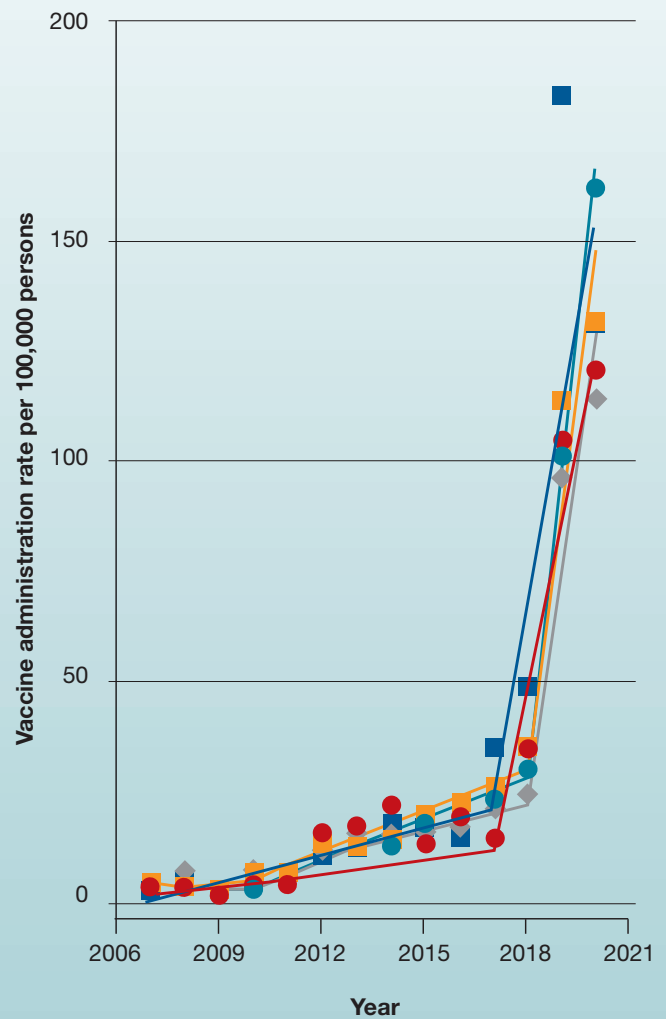
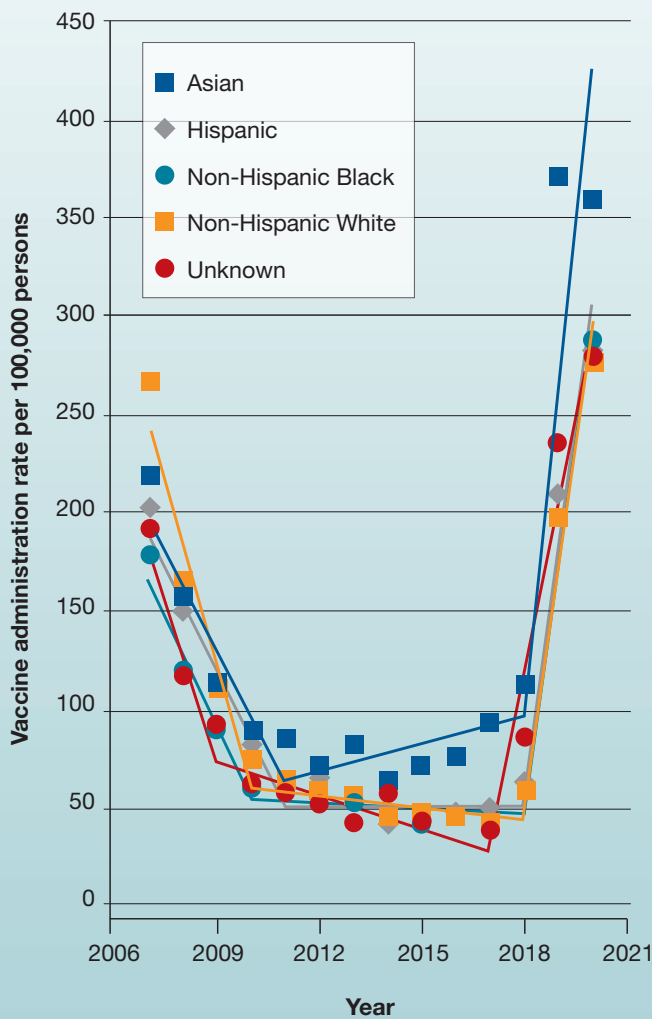
Trends in HPV vaccination among adults aged 27 to 45 years
